

The science is clear. Your actions are delaying the necessary shift to renewable energy. Instead, your support for fossil fuels is fueling the problem, making you partly responsible for the fires which have ravaged Australia in the last few months.

This cannot continue. Too much is at stake. To combat ever-worsening fire seasons Australia and all countries need to urgently reduce carbon emissions and transition to technologies that will not disrupt the climate.

We are calling on you to end your disastrous practice of funding fossil fuel companies and polluting coal, oil and gas projects. This includes immediately stopping lending to any company or project that will expand the scale of the coal, oil or gas industries and setting dates by which your exposure to these industries will reach zero.

These dates must be in line with what is necessary to keep global warming below 1.5 degrees.

There is no time to waste. Our lives have already been turned upside down by bushfire. Ending your support for destructive fossil fuels could save the lives and livelihoods of many more people by helping prevent future fires.

Please don't wait until the fire is at your own door. By then, it is too late.
