Specifically, the prospectus supplement (Exhibit A) stated, "We will not knowingly allocate any proceeds from the sale of the bonds to activities related to coal-fired power generation." But in truth, media reports indicate that JICA is using at least a portion of the bond proceeds to finance multiple coal-fired power plants in Bangladesh and Indonesia.
